Request For IPI-Iowa Prison Industries Products Through A Private Contractor

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Request Process & Instructions

Effective December 31, 2015, the Code of Iowa was modified to allow IPI – Iowa Prison Industries to sell products to a general contractor when the products purchased will be sold to public entity. The specific code language is located below these instructions for reference.

- 1. IPI has either been selected by a General Contractor to supply products or is in the process of providing pricing to a General Contractor to supply products for your public entity.
- 2. IPI staff fills out page 1 from "Today's Date" through "Products to be Bid / Supplied by IPI."
- 3. Authorized personnel gives written approval to IPI staff.
- 4. Request is provided first to IPI Sales Director and then to IPI Director for approval. Once approved:
 - a. For a project whose sales price is less than \$100,000, IPI will proceed with the project and report to the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
 - b. For projects greater than \$100,000, the IPI Director will inform the Board via email of its intention to proceed. Board members may request that the IPI Director provide additional information or schedule a teleconference meeting to discuss and consider the proposed sale within one week of email. In the case of no comments back from the Board, IPI will proceed with the project and the Board will formally ratify it at the next regularly scheduled Board meeting.
- 5. Results of requests are provided to IPI staff and posted on the IPI website.

lowa Code 201—37.2(904) Sale of products.

37.2(1) lowa state industries shall sell products to any tax-supported institution or governmental subdivision in any level of government, including state, county, city or school. lowa state industries may sell products to employees of such entities.

37.2(2) lowa state industries may sell products to nonprofit organizations such as parochial schools, churches, or fraternal organizations and employees of such nonprofit organizations.

37.2(3) lowa state industries may sell products to nonprofit health care facilities serving Medicaid or social security patients.

37.2(4) Sales will not generally be solicited from the general public. However, the state director of lowa state industries may determine with the advice of the prison industries advisory board that limited public sales will be made when the sales to political subdivisions are insufficient to justify continued operation of a shop.

37.2(5) lowa state industries may sell products to a general contractor when the products purchased will be sold to a public entity as provided in subrules 37.2(1) to 37.2(3). The public entity shall submit a written request to lowa state industries specifying the products and quantities to be purchased. Such sales shall be limited to contractors involved in construction, renovation, and remodeling projects. Sales to a general contractor shall be approved by the lowa prison industries advisory board.
