This product is ready to use but can be diluted equally with water, if desired for general use.

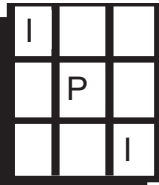

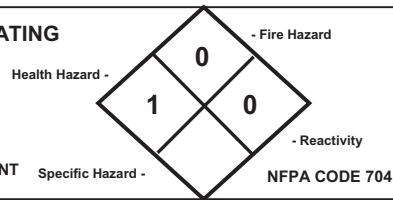
