

Cabinet Measuring Guide

IPI's Cabinet Measuring Guide is a tool for collecting necessary information to help you determine how your space can function.

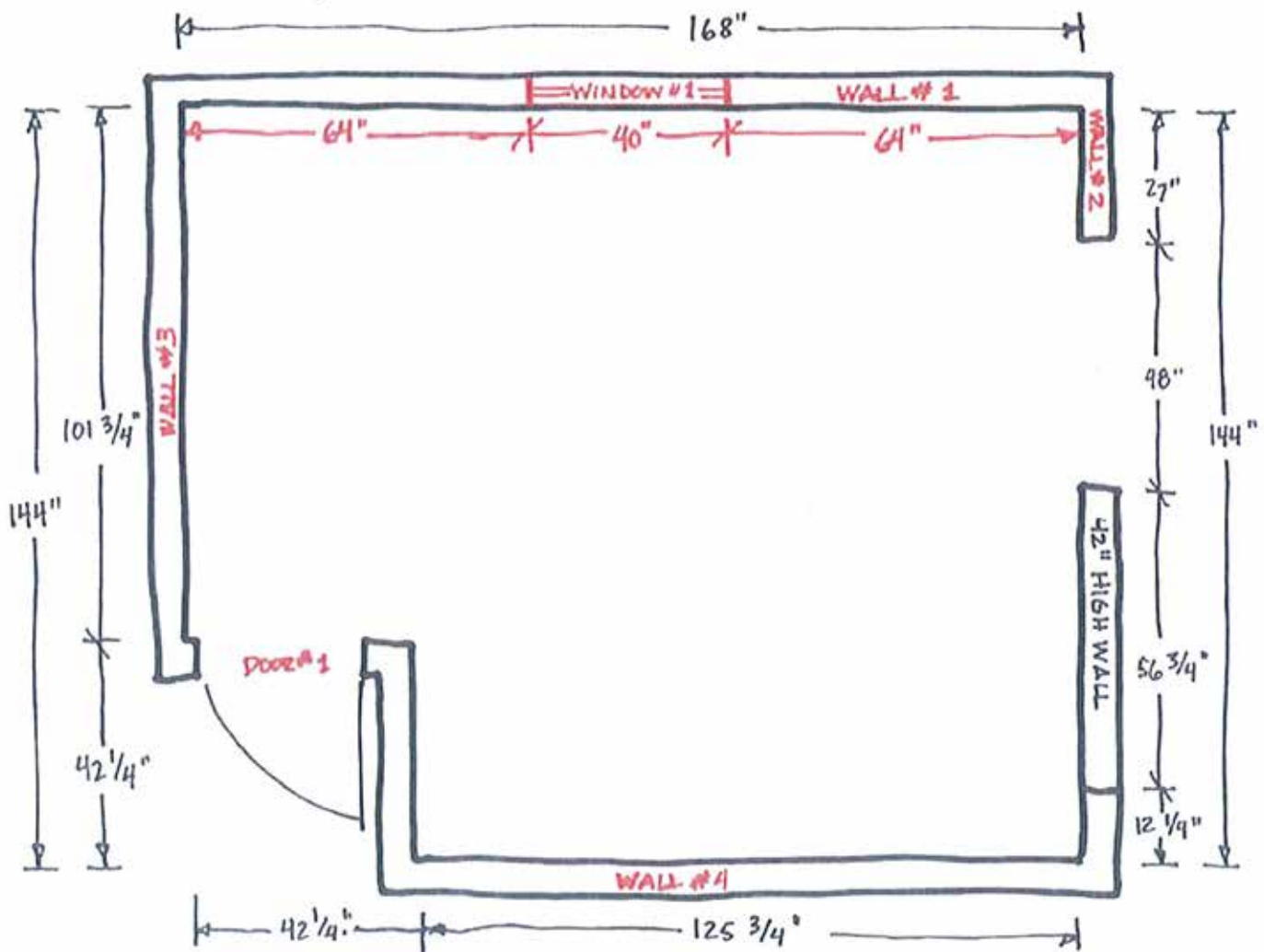
This does not need to be a work of art, but just a clear and accurate drawing of your space. You may need an extra hand in holding the measuring tape for longer measurements.



Step 1: Measure Room

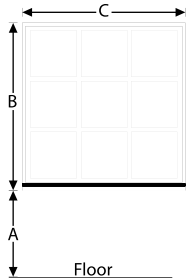
Accurate measurements are essential for a successful design. By following these simple instructions, you can provide the information needed to ensure proper fit of cabinetry and appliances. So, let's get started. You may use plain paper, or if you prefer, graph paper is provided on page 3 of this guide.

Begin by measuring your existing room floor plan. For best results, it is recommended to measure all walls at a point about 36 inches above the floor. You'll want the tape measure to be taut when measuring, so an extra set of hands will be helpful. Begin in one corner of the room and measure adjacent wall. Record this measurement (in inches), and proceed to next wall. Repeat until all walls are measured. Now, make a rough sketch of floor plan and transfer measurements to outside perimeter of drawing as shown below.

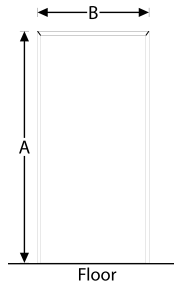


Step 3: Measure Door & Window Openings

Measure each door and window in the kitchen and record on charts provided. Always measure from outside edge of trim to outside edge of trim. All measurements are to be stated in inches.
